

## Premier's Reading Challenge 2020

Monday 24<sup>th</sup> February 2020

The Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC) is an excellent opportunity to help your child improve their reading.

### Completing the Challenge

- Students must read from the PRC list to complete the challenge
- Students can also read five of their own books from home
- Kindergarten to Year 2 students must experience **30** PRC books. This includes reading books to your child
- Students in Years 3-6 must read **20** books independently
- Please note allowances are made for students with special needs and students with little English to ensure they are also able to participate in the challenge
- Information regarding logging your child's books on the PRC website were sent home in Week 4. The note was also posted on Facebook for your reference. Spare notes can be found in the Office Foyer if this note has been misplaced
- If you do not have access to the Internet reading logs will be available in the Library

### Challenge Dates

- The challenge officially launches on the **Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> March**
- The challenge finishes on **Friday 28<sup>th</sup> August**. If you are unable to log your books online, completed reading logs must be given to Mrs Kew by this date if students wish to receive their certificate

### Certificates and Honour Roll

- All students who successfully complete a validated online reading record qualify for an official PRC certificate and will appear on the PRC Honour Roll
- The certificate shows the student's name and school. **Only** student names will appear in the Honour roll with no other identifying factors
