
Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC)

Did you know you can log your child's books online for the PRC?

A link to the Premier's Reading Challenge website can be found in the Student Portal under the Learning section. Students are also able to add a link to the PRC in the My Link List section to make the PRC easier to find. The URL to use is http://online.det.nsw.edu.au/prc.

Students can also log in directly to the <u>PRC website</u> using their Department of Education (DoE) username and password. These are the same details a student would use to access the Student Portal and the computer network at school. Log in cards will be sent home with your child by Week 4 with their Student Portal username and password details on them to assist with this process.
